Dr. Moyeen was a brilliant promising physician who graduated from Dhaka Medical College in 1998. Later he did his FCPS (Medicine) and MD (cardiology) from Dhaka Medical College, Dhaka.

He was posted as the Assistant Professor at Sylhet Osmani Medical College. In the wave of epidemic of COVID-19, he was infected in the early April. He was transferred by road to Dhaka when his condition deteriorated. He was under treatment at Kurmitola General Hospital and passed away on 15th April. (Inna lillahi wa inna ilayhi raji'un) early morning. He left behind his wife and 2 children.

Bangladesh Cardiac Society expressed its deep respect for the departed soul and pray to Allah so that his soul be in the eternal peace. Our heartfelt sympathy is to his family.
